**POC UPDATES:**

Disc golf - John -upcoming maintenance and reconfiguring of course -date TBD

Centennial Park - Alicia - Wildlife area south of lake - walk out the area today and ask town for permission for a set apart wildlife area

Fountain - lake water level is low so will not be installed in lake this summer. Also, there are too many people hanging off of it.

Discussion on having no water craft allowed on the lake this summer, fishing limited to certain hours, not allowed between 10:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. -Reid will ask for emergency vote from council

Gazebo - discussed the concrete steps and pads by gazebo. Alicia has one bid for the work, but will research further bids and donations

Glen Park - Reid - people seem to be obeying the caution no use tape. Big drop at end of slide needs to be corrected and how to add protective rails on both sides of slide platform. Alicia would like to have Parks use the Trex boards that she has stored at her place.

**RESERVOIR TRAILHEAD PARKING** - a new sub-committee has been formed to resolve parking problems
